AN ACT TO PROVIDE DISTINCTIVE LICENSE PLATES FOR SURVIVORS OF THE PEARL HARBOR ATTACK.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 2 of Chapter 90, as appearing in the 1986 Official
2 Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the word
3 "individual" in line 142, the following: — The registrar of motor
4 vehicles may for a fee, to the survivors of the Pearl Harbor attack
5 on December 7, 1941, upon presentation of satisfactory evidence
6 of such military service at that location during the attack, as
7 determined by the registrar, distinctive registration plates for one
8 pleasure vehicle owned and principally used by said individual.
