An Act providing for Forfeiture Values in Insurance Policies issued by Foreign Insurance Companies after Three Full Annual Premiums have been paid.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

2 one hundred and forty-four, of the General Laws,

4 serting after the word "seven" and before the word
5 "the" in the third line the words:—or by any
6 foreign life insurance company after December
