Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Notwithstanding the provisions of any other general or
- 2 special law to the contrary, school buses, as defined in section
- 3 one of chapter ninety of the General Laws, shall be exempt
- 4 from "the periodic motor vehicle inspection", so-called.
