In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-Six.

AN ACT PROVIDING THAT MEAT SOLD AT RETAIL IN PACKAGES SHALL
BE CONTAINED IN TRANSPARENT CASINGS OR COVERS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as
follows:*

1 Chapter 94 of the General Laws is hereby amended by
2 inserting after section 181, as most recently amended by chapter
3 244 of the acts of 1960, the following section: —

4 *Section 181A.* No person shall himself or by his agent or
5 servant sell or offer for sale at retail any meat in package
6 form unless such package contains a transparent casing or
7 cover which permits visable inspection of the contents thereof
8 from all sides. This act shall take effect upon nine months after
9 its passage.
