By Mr. Edward L. Burke, a petition (accompanied by bill, Senate, No. 2334) of Edward L. Burke and Chester G. Atkins (with the approval of the county commissioners) for legislation to direct Middlesex County to pay certain retirement benefits to the surviving spouse of Edward F. Henneberry, Jr. Public Service.

AN ACT DIRECTING MIDDLESEX COUNTY TO PAY CERTAIN RETIREMENT BENEFITS TO THE SURVIVING SPOUSE OF EDWARD F. HENNEBERRY, JR.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of any general
2 or special law to the contrary, for the purpose of promoting
3 the public good, the retirement board of Middlesex County is
4 hereby authorized and directed to pay to Pauline Henneberry,
5 the surviving spouse of Edward F. Henneberry, Jr., the sheriff
6 of Middlesex County, an accidental death benefit as provided
7 under the provisions of section nine of chapter thirty-two of
8 the general laws.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect as of November eigh-
2 teenth, nineteen hundred and eighty-four.

The Government of the State of New York

AN ACT TO AMEND THE LAW RELATIVE TO THE REGISTRATION OF VOTERS IN THE SEVERAL COUNTIES OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, AND TO REPEAL AN ACT TO AMEND THE LAW RELATIVE TO THE REGISTRATION OF VOTERS IN THE SEVERAL COUNTIES OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, PASSED IN THE SENATE AND ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, APRIL TWENTY-NINE, NINETEEN HUNDRED AND TWO.

1. Section 1. The following provisions of the constitution of the State of New York shall be amended, to-wit:
2. Article III, section 1, paragraph 1, shall be amended to read:
3. "The right of suffrage shall be extended to all persons who are citizens of the State of New York, and who are twenty-one years of age on the day of the election, and who have resided in the State of New York for a period of six months immediately preceding the day of the election, and who have been duly registered as voters in the several counties of the State of New York."
4. Article III, section 1, paragraph 2, shall be amended to read:
5. "The right of suffrage shall be extended to all persons who are citizens of the State of New York, and who are twenty-one years of age on the day of the election, and who have resided in the State of New York for a period of six months immediately preceding the day of the election, and who have been duly registered as voters in the several counties of the State of New York."
6. Article III, section 1, paragraph 3, shall be amended to read:
7. "The right of suffrage shall be extended to all persons who are citizens of the State of New York, and who are twenty-one years of age on the day of the election, and who have resided in the State of New York for a period of six months immediately preceding the day of the election, and who have been duly registered as voters in the several counties of the State of New York."
8. Article III, section 1, paragraph 4, shall be amended to read:
9. "The right of suffrage shall be extended to all persons who are citizens of the State of New York, and who are twenty-one years of age on the day of the election, and who have resided in the State of New York for a period of six months immediately preceding the day of the election, and who have been duly registered as voters in the several counties of the State of New York."

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect on the first day of January next, and shall be published in the official gazette of the State of New York.
