AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE COMMONWEALTH TO REIMBURSE THE TOWN OF PEPPERELL FOR CERTAIN MONIES EXPENDED FOR VETERANS' BENEFITS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 There shall be allowed and paid out of state treasury to
2 the town of Pepperell, subject to appropriation and subject
3 to the approval of the commissioner of veterans' services,
4 such sum, not exceeding nine thousand, eight hundred and
5 seventy-four dollars and seventy-three cents, as said town
6 would have been entitled to receive in reimbursement for
7 veterans' benefits paid by it in the years nineteen hundred
8 and sixty-five, sixty-six and sixty-seven, under the provi-
9 sions of section six of chapter one hundred and fifteen of the
10 General Laws, had said town made a proper and seasonable
11 report thereof to said commissioner as required by said sec-
12 tion six.
