

HOUSE No. 1054

By Mr. Coury of New Bedford, petition of Edward P. Coury that certain provisions of the State Sanitary Code shall not be applicable to single family dwellings occupied by the owner. Social Welfare.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-One.

AN ACT PROVIDING THAT ARTICLE II OF THE STATE SANITARY CODE SHALL NOT BE APPLICABLE TO ANY SINGLE DWELLING WHICH IS OCCUPIED BY THE OWNER THEREOF.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding the provisions of any law or directive,
2 Article II of the state sanitary code, as prescribed by the de-
3 partment of public health, shall not be applicable to a single
4 dwelling which is occupied by the owner thereof.
