AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE CITY COUNCIL AND MAYOR OF THE CITY OF PITTSFIELD TO ALLOW THE SALE AT RETAIL OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES NOT TO BE DRUNK ON THE PREMISES BETWEEN THE HOURS OF TEN O'CLOCK ANTEMERIDIAN AND EIGHT O'CLOCK POSTMERIDIAN ON SUNDAYS AND LEGAL HOLIDAYS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of General Laws
2 chapter 138, sections fifteen and thirty-three, or any other general
3 or special law to the contrary, the City Council and Mayor of the
4 City of Pittsfield, through the City's Licensing Board, are hereby
5 authorized and empowered to allow holders of licenses for the
6 sale at retail of alcoholic beverages not to be drunk on the
7 premises to sell such alcoholic beverages between the hours of ten
8 o'clock antemeridian and eight o'clock postmeridian on Sundays
9 and legal holidays.

1 SECTION 2. This Act shall be effective upon passage.
