AN ACT VALIDATING THE ACTS AND PROCEEDINGS AT THE  
ADJOURNED SESSION OF THE ANNUAL TOWN MEETING OF  
THE TOWN OF WELLESLEY FOR THE CURRENT YEAR HELD  
ON MARCH TWENTY-NINTH, NINETEEN HUNDRED AND  
FIFTY-FIVE.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in  
General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same,  
as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The acts and proceedings of the town of  
2 Wellesley at the adjourned session of the annual town  
3 meeting for the current year, which adjourned session  
4 was held on Tuesday, March twenty-ninth, nineteen  
5 hundred and fifty-five, and all acts done in pursuance  
6 thereof, are hereby confirmed and declared valid, not-  
7 withstanding the failure to give notice of the adjourn-  
8 ment as required by the by-laws of said town, to the  
9 same extent as if the said adjourned session had been  
10 called, held, conducted and adjourned in strict compli-  
11 ance with the law and said by-laws.
