By Mr. Grimley of Lawrence, petition of Edward J. Grimley, Jr., that motor vehicles be equipped with reflectorized signal devices or flares. Public Safety.

AN ACT REQUIRING MOTOR VEHICLES TO BE EQUIPPED WITH REFLECTORIZED SIGNAL DEVICES OR FLARES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 7 of chapter 90 of the General Laws, as most
2 recently amended by chapter 149 of the acts of 1972 is hereby
3 further amended by adding at the end of the first paragraph
4 the following sentence: — Every motor vehicle operated in or
5 upon any way shall be equipped with at least two flares which
6 may be lighted and placed on the way in the event of
7 emergency or said vehicle shall be equipped with at least two
8 reflectorized devices which may be placed on the way in the
9 event of an emergency, of such minimum standards of
10 construction and performance as the registrar may prescribe.
