AN ACT ELIMINATING THE REQUIREMENT THAT, AT THE COMMENCEMENT OF AN ACTION FOR DIVORCE, THE PARTIES HAVE BEEN LIVING APART FOR A PERIOD OF NOT LESS THAN THIRTY (30) DAYS.
