AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE EXPENSE OF RECORDING OF PROBATE PROCEEDINGS IN SUFFOLK COUNTY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 56 of chapter 215 of the General Laws is hereby
2 amended by striking out, in line 3, the words "forty-five
3 hundred dollars" and substituting in place thereof: - nine
4 thousand dollars.
