Bill accompanying the petition of Frank H. Pope for legislation to provide for the proper inspection of concrete buildings. Mercantile Affairs. January 23.

Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eight.

AN ACT

Relative to Buildings constructed of Concrete.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. No buildings shall be constructed of
2 concrete in any city or town, unless the manner and ma-
3 terial of construction are inspected and duly approved
4 by the inspector of buildings of such city or town, or if
5 there is no inspector then by some person appointed for
6 the purpose by the mayor of the city or the selectmen
7 of the town.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
