### AN ACT ESTABLISHING THE THIRD SUNDAY IN JUNE AS FATHER'S DAY.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Chapter 6 of the General Laws is hereby amended
- 2 by adding the following section:—
- 3 *Section 15B.* The governor shall annually issue a
- 4 proclamation setting apart the third Sunday in June
- 5 each year as Father's Day, and recommending its ob-
- 6 servance as a day set apart in the honor and remem-
- 7 brance of fathers and as a public expression of love
- 8 and reverence for the fathers of our state and as an
- 9 inspiration for better homes and closer ties between
- 10 the home and our commonwealth.
