## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF THE DIVISION OF FISHERIES AND GAME TO ISSUE A STAMP TO BE CARRIED BY CERTAIN PERSONS HUNTING DEER BY BOW AND ARROW.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Chapter 131 of the General Laws is hereby amended by in-
- 2 serting after section 80A the following section: — *Section 80B.*
- 3 No person shall hunt deer during the exclusive archery season
- 4 on deer as established by the director unless he has attached
- 5 to the back of his hunting or sporting license, in the manner
- 6 provided by the director, a stamp authorizing him so to hunt.
- 7 The director is hereby authorized to issue such stamp, in such
- 8 form as he may determine.
- 9 The fee for such stamp shall be one dollar and ten cents.
- 10 Any city or town clerk issuing such stamp may retain ten
- 11 cents from said fee.
