By Mr. Curtiss of Sheffield, petition of Sidney Q. Curtiss and another for legislation to authorize the payment to members of the teachers retirement system or their estates of accumulated sick leave benefits. Public Service.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE PAYMENT TO MEMBERS OF THE TEACHERS RETIREMENT SYSTEM OR THEIR ESTATE OF A CERTAIN SUM FOR ACCUMULATED SICK LEAVE BENEFITS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Subdivision (2) of section 13 of chapter 32 of the
2 General Laws as most recently amended by chapter 536 of the
3 acts of 1957 is further amended by adding after paragraph (c) the
4 following paragraph: —

5 (d) Whenever the employment of any member of the teachers
6 retirement system is terminated because of retirement or death,
7 such person or his estate shall be paid at his regular per diem
8 rate of compensation for every day of accumulative sick leave
9 to which he was entitled at the date of such termination, pro-
10 vided, however, such payment shall not exceed one thousand
11 dollars.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall apply to all persons who have been
2 retired on or after June first, nineteen hundred and sixty-eight.
