## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Two.

### AN ACT RELATIVE TO A MINIMUM SALARY FOR PUBLIC SCHOOL TEACHERS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 40 of chapter 71 of the General Laws  
2 as most recently amended by chapter 278 of the acts of 1968  
3 is hereby amended by striking out the first sentence and  
4 inserting in place thereof the following sentence: — The com-  
5 pensation of every teacher employed in any public day school  
6 in the commonwealth, except persons in training and those  
7 employed as temporary substitutes, shall be at a rate of not  
8 less than eight thousand five hundred dollars for the school  
9 year.

1 SECTION 2. Section 1 of this act shall be effective Sep-  
2 tember 1, 1972.
