AN ACT REGULATING BLASTING IN THE VICINITY OF CEMETERIES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 114 of the General Laws is hereby amended by
- 2 inserting after section 18 the following section: —
- 3 *Section 18A.* No person shall conduct deep rock blasting
- 4 and drilling within one thousand feet of an existing cemetery
- 5 except for the purpose of laying or repairing sewer, water or
- 6 public utility lines in order to protect treasured monuments
- 7 and to maintain the peaceful, undisturbed existence of grave
- 8 sites.

The Commission of Government

to the President of the United States

AN ACT TO ESTABLISH A COMMISSION OF GOVERNMENT

It is enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled, That

Section 1. That there be and there is hereby established a Commission of Government, to be known as the Commission of Government, to study and report to the President of the United States on the subject of the organization and functions of the executive branch of the Government, and to make such recommendations as it may deem proper.
