

**Chap. 482.** AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF BRISTOL TO BORROW A SUM OF MONEY FOR THE REPAIR AND RENOVATION OF THE COURT HOUSE OF THE SECOND DISTRICT COURT OF BRISTOL IN THE CITY OF FALL RIVER.

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

SECTION 1. The county commissioners of the county of Bristol are hereby authorized to expend a sum not exceeding one hundred thousand dollars for the repair, alteration and renovation of the second district court of Bristol court house in the city of Fall River.

SECTION 2. To provide the necessary funds for the repair, alteration and renovation, authorized by section one of this act, the treasurer of the county of Bristol, with the approval of said county commissioners, may borrow a sum not exceeding one hundred thousand dollars, and may issue bonds therefor, which shall bear on their face the words, Bristol County Court House Loan, Act of 1970. Such bonds shall be payable in such annual installments, beginning not more than one year from the date thereof, as will extinguish the loan in not more than five years from their dates, and so that the amount of such annual payment in any year shall not be less than the amount of the principal of the loan payable in any subsequent year. Such bonds shall be signed by the treasurer of the county and countersigned by a majority of said county commissioners. The county may sell said securities at public or private sale upon such terms and conditions as said county commissioners may deem proper, but not less than their par value.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

**Chap. 483.** AN ACT INCREASING THE SALARIES OF THE MEMBERS AND THE SECRETARY OF THE LICENSING BOARD FOR THE CITY OF BOSTON AND REPEALING OBSOLETE PROVISIONS OF LAW CONCERNING ROOMS FOR THE PERFORMANCE OF ITS FUNCTIONS.

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

SECTION 1. Chapter 291 of the acts of 1906 is hereby amended by striking out section 2, as most recently amended by section 1 of chapter 62 of the acts of 1955, and inserting in place thereof the following section: —

*Section 2.* The annual salary of the chairman of said board shall be sixteen thousand dollars, that of each of the other two members fifteen thousand five hundred dollars and that of the secretary fifteen thousand five hundred dollars. Such salaries shall be paid in monthly installments by the city of Boston.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
