AN ACT PROHIBITING CERTAIN TELEPHONE CHARGES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 19 of chapter 159 of the General laws, as appearing in
- 2 the 1996 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the
- 3 first sentence the following sentence:— Such schedules shall not
- 4 include a rate, fare toll or charge to any customer for the use of a
- 5 touch tone telephone.
