The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Four.

AN ACT ESTABLISHING A COMMITTEE TO SAVE ENERGY.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter 6 of the Massachusetts General Laws is amended  
2 by adding, at the end, a new section one hundred seventy-nine:

3 Committee to Save Energy

4 *Section 179.* Establishment; Composition; Appointments;  
5 Duties; Awards; Reports

6 There shall be a committee to save energy, hereinafter called  
7 the committee, consisting of the governor or his designee, the  
8 commissioner of public utilities or his designee, and five mem-  
9 bers to be appointed by the governor for a term of two years.  
10 The committee shall solicit and accept ideas from residents of  
11 the Commonwealth on ways to conserve energy in the Com-  
12 monwealth.

13 The members of the Committee shall serve without compen-  
14 sation. They shall be reimbursed for expenses incurred in  
15 publicizing their efforts.

16 They shall, twice a year, give five prizes of two hundred  
17 dollars apiece to citizens who present to them the most signifi-  
18 cant ideas for saving energy in the state of Massachusetts.

19 The committee shall make an annual report to the general  
20 court and a copy thereof shall be sent to the governor and the  
21 state secretary.

- 4 Section 5. Establishment; Composition; Appointment;
- 5 Section 6. Duties; Annual Reports.
- 6 There shall be a committee to save energy, hereinafter called
- 7 the committee, consisting of the governor or his designee, the
- 8 commissioner of public utilities or his designee, and two mem-
- 9 bers to be appointed by the governor for a term of two years.
- 10 The committee shall select and accept ideas from residents of
- 11 the Commonwealth on ways to conserve energy in the Com-
- 12 monwealth.
- 13 The members of the Committee shall serve without compen-
- 14 sation. They shall be reimbursed for expenses incurred in
- 15 performing their duties.
- 16 They shall, twice a year give five copies of two hundred
- 17 dollars apiece to citizens who present to them the most significant
- 18 and best ideas for saving energy in the state of Minnesota.

- 21 state treasury.
