

HOUSE No. 1847

By Mr. Jenness of Quincy, petition of William W. Jenness for legislation relative to the amounts of non-contributory pensions payable to certain employees of certain cities and towns. Pensions and Old Age Assistance.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Fifty-Two.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE AMOUNTS OF NON-CONTRIBUTORY PENSIONS PAYABLE TO CERTAIN EMPLOYEES OF CERTAIN CITIES AND TOWNS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Any employee or former employee,
2 other than a policeman or fireman, of a city or town
3 which accepts this act as hereinafter provided, who
4 has been or shall be granted a non-contributory
5 pension on or after November first, nineteen hundred
6 and forty-nine and prior to January first, nineteen
7 hundred and fifty-three, shall be entitled to the
8 pension increases granted by chapter eight hundred
9 and twenty of the acts of nineteen hundred and fifty
10 and chapter seven hundred and eighty-one of the
11 acts of nineteen hundred and fifty-one. Except as
12 provided herein, the granting of said increases shall
13 be subject to the provisions of said chapters eight

14 hundred and twenty and seven hundred and eighty-
15 one.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective in a
2 city having a Plan E charter when accepted by the
3 affirmative vote of a majority of all the members of
4 the city council, and, in the case of other cities by
5 vote of the city council subject to the provisions of
6 the charter, and in a town by a majority vote at a
7 town meeting.
