## **The Commonwealth of Massachusetts**

AN ACT PROHIBITING THE WATER RESOURCES AUTHORITY FROM SITING A SLUDGE INCINERATOR IN A MUNICIPALITY WHICH HAS A SEWAGE TREATMENT FACILITY.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Section 7 of chapter 372 of the acts of 1984 is hereby amended
- 2 by inserting after clause (h) the following clause: — (i)
- 3 Notwithstanding the provisions of any special or general law to
- 4 the contrary, the authority shall not locate, site, construct,
- 5 reconstruct, purchase, rent, lease or operate a sludge incinerator
- 6 in any city or town in the commonwealth in which there currently
- 7 exists a facility for the treatment of sewage.
