AN ACT PROVIDING AN EXEMPTION FROM TAX FOR AMOUNTS PAID FOR REAL ESTATE TAXES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 5B of chapter 62 of the General Laws, as inserted
- 2 by chapter 555 of the acts of 1971, is hereby amended by
- 3 inserting after subsection (7) the following subsection: —
- 4 (8) An exemption equal to the amount of taxes on real
- 5 estate paid by the taxpayer or his spouse.
