## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

AN ACT PROVIDING THAT HARBOR MASTERS AND ASSISTANT HARBOR MASTERS HAVE POLICE POWERS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Chapter 102 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting
- 2 after section 19 the following section:—
- 3 *Section 19A.* Harbor masters and assistant harbor masters
- 4 shall have the powers and duties of police officers as set forth in
- 5 section ninety-eight or chapter twenty-one of the General Laws.
