AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE CIVIL SERVICE STATUS OF THE SUPERVISOR OF RECREATION UNDER THE YOUTH SERVICE BOARD.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The person who holds the office of supervisor of
2 recreation, under the youth service board, shall on
3 the effective date of this act, become subject to the
4 civil service laws and rules, and his tenure of office
5 shall be unlimited, subject, however, to said laws,
6 but he shall be subject to a qualifying examination by
7 the division of civil service, and upon passing said
8 examination shall be certified for said office and shall
9 be deemed to be permanently appointed thereto with-
10 out being required to serve any probationary period.
