AN ACT TO PROVIDE MENTAL HEALTH SERVICES TO CERTAIN ABUSED CHILDREN AND YOUTHS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 19 of the General Laws is hereby amended by adding
2 after section 29 the following section: —
3 *Section 29.* The department shall provide mental health serv-
4 ices to children who are wards of the commonwealth who are
5 physically or emotionally injured and to children or youth found
6 by the department of youth services to not be dangerous to them-
7 selves or others. The department shall also provide services to
8 families of said children or youths. A program of services shall be
9 established by the department, the agency involved and the office
10 for children.
