AN ACT RELATIVE TO PAYMENT OF FUNERAL AND BURIAL EXPENSES.

Whereas, the deferred operation of this act would tend to defeat its purpose which is to provide adequate remuneration to the families of Police officers and Firefighters killed in the line of duty. Therefore it shall be declared to be an emergency law and necessary for the preservation of public convenience.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:
