AN ACT CONCERNING NUMBER PLATES FOR SPECIAL AMATEUR RADIO LICENSEES OF PASSENGER, COMMERCIAL OR RECREATIONAL VEHICLES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The sixth paragraph of section 2 of Chapter 90 of the General
2 Laws is hereby amended after the fifth sentence by inserting the
3 following two sentences: — The registrar shall also, upon payment
4 of the fee required in section thirty-three, upon registration of a
5 private passenger vehicle, commercial motor vehicle or recreation-
6 al vehicle, issue special number plates bearing the official call
7 letters of such radio station as assigned by the federal communica-
8 tions commission. Each application for such special number plates
9 shall be accompanied by proof satisfactory to the registrar that the
10 applicant currently holds such a license.
