

# HOUSE . . . . . No. 2453

By Mr. Travis of Rehoboth, petition of Philip Travis for legislation to authorize the Registrar of Motor Vehicles to issue distinctive motor vehicle plates for certain vehicles commonly called "street rods". Public Safety.

## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Ninety-Five.

AN ACT PROVIDING FOR A REGISTRATION NUMBER PLATE FOR CERTAIN "STREET RODS", SO-CALLED.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Section 2 of chapter 90 of the General Laws is hereby amended
- 2 by adding at the end thereof the following paragraph:—
- 3 The registrar shall furnish a distinctive registration plate for
- 4 vehicles called "street rods", which shall be issued for a fee suffi-
- 5 cient to cover the cost of manufacturing and issuing the same. The
- 6 registrar may, by regulation, describe the vehicles qualifying for
- 7 such designation after consultation with interested persons.
