### AN ACT AUTHORIZING COUNTY COMMISSIONERS TO SELL LAND ACQUIRED FOR TUBERCULOSIS HOSPITAL PURPOSES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter 111 of the General Laws is hereby amended by strik-  
2 ing out section 86, as appearing in the Tercentenary Edition,  
3 and inserting in place thereof the following section:—

4 *Section 86.* Subject to section eighty-two, county commis-  
5 sioners may purchase, lease or take by eminent domain, under  
6 chapter seventy-nine, such land, not exceeding five hundred  
7 acres, as they may deem necessary or convenient for the pur-  
8 poses set forth in sections seventy-eight to ninety, inclusive.

9 **Said commissioners may in their discretion sell land**  
10 **acquired for said purposes.**
