## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-Three.

### AN ACT CONCERNING REIMBURSEMENT OF CITIES AND TOWNS BY THE COMMONWEALTH FOR ADMINISTERING ASSISTANCE TO DISABLED PERSONS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 20 of chapter 118D of the General Laws is hereby  
2 amended by striking out the first sentence, as appearing in sec-  
3 tion 9 of chapter 353 of the acts of 1952, and inserting in place  
4 thereof the following sentence:— In addition to the amount of  
5 federal reimbursement paid under section nineteen to a town  
6 rendering assistance under this chapter, such town shall be re-  
7 imburSED by the commonwealth in an additional amount which,  
8 together with the federal reimbursement, shall amount to  
9 seventy-five per cent of the assistance expenditures which have  
10 been lawfully incurred under this chapter and in a further amount  
11 equal to one half of so much of the amounts expended by such  
12 town for administering this chapter as exceeds the federal re-  
13 imbursement for such administration; except that expenses of  
14 administering this chapter shall be available to welfare districts  
15 established under chapter one hundred and seventeen and cities  
16 and towns which have entered into combinations under chapter  
17 one hundred and eighteen B only as provided in said chapters  
18 one hundred and seventeen and one hundred and eighteen B.
