
By Mr. Zarod, a petition (accompanied by bill, Senate, No. 1051) of Stanley J. Zarod for legislation to provide for increasing the number of assistant district attorneys in the Western District and establishing their salaries. Public Service.

AN ACT PROVIDING FOR INCREASING THE NUMBER OF ASSISTANT DISTRICT ATTORNEYS IN THE WESTERN DISTRICT AND ESTABLISHING THEIR SALARIES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 14 of Chapter 12, as most recently
2 amended by section 1 of chapter 1117 of the acts of 1971, is
3 hereby amended by striking out the words "For the western
4 district, eight assistant district attorneys", and inserting in
5 place thereof the following words:

6 For the western district, fourteen assistant district attorneys.

1 SECTION 2. Section 16 of Chapter 12, as most recently
2 amended by section 2 of chapter 696 of the acts of 1972, is
3 hereby amended by strikng out the words "for the western
4 district, one assistant, eleven thousand five hundred dollars;
5 two assistants, ten thousand five hundred dollars; five assist-
6 ants, nine thousand five hundred dollars", and inserting in
7 place thereof the following words:

8 For the western district, one assistant, fourteen thousand
9 eight hundred dollars; one assistant, thirteen thousand seven
10 hundred dollars; six assistants, eleven thousand four hundred
11 dollars; six assistants, ten thouand dollar.
