I further declare that in my opinion said law is an emergency law and the facts constituting the emergency are as follows:

So that bonds may be issued immediately for the financing of a new health services building which is urgently needed by the hospital.

Chap. 630. AN ACT FURTHER INCREASING THE AMOUNT OF REAL AND PERSONAL PROPERTY THAT THE SAINT VINCENT HOSPITAL OF WORCESTER, MASSACHUSETTS MAY HOLD.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

Chapter 770 of the acts of 1951, as amended by chapter 495 of the acts of 1963, is hereby further amended by striking out, in line 4, the word "twenty" and inserting in place thereof the word:—thirty,—so as to read as follows:—

The Saint Vincent Hospital of Worcester, Massachusetts, a corporation incorporated under general law, is hereby authorized to hold, for the purposes for which it is incorporated, real and personal estate to an amount not exceeding thirty million dollars.

Chap. 631. AN ACT INCREASING THE AMOUNT OF PROPERTY THAT MAY BE HELD BY THE SALEM HOSPITAL.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

The Salem Hospital, a charitable corporation organized under general law in the year one thousand eight hundred and seventy-three, may hold real and personal property to an amount not exceeding thirty-five million dollars, said property to be used for the purposes set forth in its agreement of association. *Approved August 5, 1970.*
