## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Five.

AN ACT TO PERMIT THE TOWN OF GOSHEN TO HOLD ITS ANNUAL TOWN MEETING AFTER THE CLOSE OF THE FISCAL YEAR.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Notwithstanding the provisions of section 9 of Chapter 39
- 2 of the General Laws, the town of Goshen may hold its annual
- 3 town meeting after the end of the fiscal year.
