SENATE No. 283

To accompany the petition of Wendell D. Rockwood and another that provision be made for funds for the department of public safety in the city of Cambridge. Taxation.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventeen.

AN ACT

To provide Funds for the Use of the Department of Public Safety in the City of Cambridge.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 For the purpose of establishing the total sum
2 of money which the city of Cambridge shall
3 annually appropriate for the expenses of the
4 department of public safety, the "taxable prop-
5 erty" of the city of Cambridge as used in chapter
6 six hundred and eleven of the acts of the year
7 nineteen hundred and twelve and acts in amend-
8 ment thereto shall hereafter be construed to
9 mean the taxes assessed by the assessors of the
10 city of Cambridge together with whatever the
11 amount turned over to the said city of Cambridge
12 by the treasurer and receiver general in con-
13 formity with section twenty-three of chapter
14 two hundred and sixty-nine of the acts of the
15 year nineteen hundred and sixteen may represent
16 of capital value.
