The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

AN ACT TO PROVIDE PROTECTION FOR EMPLOYEES OF
THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS, HOLDING SEC-
ONDARY RATINGS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 When an employee of the Department of Public
2 Works holds what is known as a "secondary rating",
3 let it be provided that such individuals can work and
4 hold such secondary rating without regard to time or
5 percentage of time.

As the amount of interest on the bonds of the State is to be paid out of the proceeds of the sale of the bonds, it is necessary that the amount of interest should not exceed the amount of the proceeds of the sale of the bonds.
