RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY THE SECRETARY OF MANPOWER AFFAIRS RELATIVE TO SUMMER EMPLOYMENT OF STUDENTS.

1 *Resolved*, That the secretary of manpower affairs be re-
2 quested to make an investigation and study of the temporary
3 summer employment practices for state positions including
4 thirty-day appointments as well as aid and assistance to students
5 in obtaining summer employment.
6 He shall report the results of his investigation and study, and
7 his recommendations, if any, together with drafts of legislation
8 necessary to carry said recommendations into effect, by filing the
9 same with the clerk of the house of representatives on or before
10 the last Wednesday of December, nineteen hundred and seventy-
11 four.
