### AN ACT ENCOURAGING THE USE OF PROGRAMMED BUDGETS BY MUNICIPAL GOVERNMENTS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary,
- 2 so-called "Programmed Budgets" may be submitted by municipal
- 3 departments, agencies or other political subdivisions, to local mu-
- 4 nicipal legislative bodies as fiscal year recommendations.
