RESOLVE

Providing for an Investigation and Study by the Department of Education of Citizenship Training.

1 *Resolved*, That the department of education is hereby
2 authorized and directed to make an investigation and
3 study of citizenship training as conducted by the state of
4 New York or any other commonwealth, and make a re-
5 port thereon and recommendations to the next annual
6 session of the legislature on or before the second Wednes-
7 day in January.
