By Messrs. Harmon of Boston and Carey of Boston, petition of Samuel Harmon and William A. Carey that certain periods of part time employment be considered creditable service under the retirement law for public employees. Pensions and Old Age Assistance.

AN ACT ESTABLISHING CREDITABLE SERVICE TO BE ALLOWED TOWARDS RETIREMENT FOR CERTAIN PART-TIME POSITIONS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Paragraph (b) of subdivision (2) of section four of chapter
2 thirty-two of the General Laws is hereby amended by adding
3 at the end of said paragraph the following: — ; and provided,
4 further, that in the case of any such employee whose position
5 is or has been established on a part-time basis and who has or
6 does perform service during any calendar year would be equal
7 to at least seven months of service if converted to a full-time
8 basis, the board shall credit such service as the equivalent of
9 one year of service.
