RESOLVE

In favor of the State Normal School at Fitchburg.

1 *Resolved*, That there be allowed and paid out of the
2 treasury of the Commonwealth the sum of seven thou-
3 sand five hundred dollars for completing and furnishing
4 the building for a model and practice school in connec-
5 tion with the state normal school at Fitchburg and for
6 grading the grounds; said amount to be expended under
7 the direction of the state board of education.
