## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Fifty-One.

RESOLVE REVIVING AND CONTINUING THE SURVEY OF THE GREAT PONDS OF THE COMMONWEALTH AND THE RIGHTS OF WAY THERETO.

1    *Resolved*, That the survey and measurement of  
2 all ponds within the commonwealth by the depart-  
3 ment of public works, acting through its division of  
4 waterways, authorized by chapter twenty-four of the  
5 resolves of nineteen hundred and fifty, is hereby  
6 revived and continued. Said department shall report  
7 to the general court on or before December thirty-  
8 first of the current year, giving the names and the  
9 locations of the ponds which have definitely been  
10 determined to be great ponds, and shall annually  
11 report on December thirty-first thereafter until the  
12 status of all ponds which are or may have been great  
13 ponds has been definitely established. In all cases  
14 the reports pertaining to these ponds shall indicate  
15 whether or not the public right of way exists to such  
16 ponds and if so, its location. Said department is  
17 authorized to expend for the purpose of this resolve  
18 such sums as may be appropriated therefor.
