AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A BRIDGE
OVER THE CHELSEA RIVER FROM A POINT AT OR NEAR
THE JUNCTION OF BORDER STREET AND CONDOR STREET
IN THE CITY OF BOSTON TO WINNISIMMET STREET IN
THE CITY OF CHELSEA.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The department of public works is
2 hereby authorized and directed to construct a bridge
3 and approaches thereto across the Chelsea river from
4 a point at or near the junction of Border street and
5 Condor street in the city of Boston to Winnisimmet
6 street in the city of Chelsea.

1 SECTION 2. The cost of said work shall not exceed
2 one million five hundred thousand dollars and fifty
3 per cent of said cost shall be paid by the common-
4 wealth from the Highway Fund, thirty per cent of
5 said cost shall be assessed on the city of Boston and
6 twenty per cent thereof shall be assessed on the city
7 of Chelsea.
