## **The Commonwealth of Massachusetts**

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Two.

AN ACT EXEMPTING ANY CHIEF POWER PLANT ENGINEER IN A STATE INSTITUTION FROM WORKING MORE THAN FORTY HOURS IN ANY WORK WEEK.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Chapter 30 of the General Laws is hereby amended by
- 2 inserting after section 24A the following section: —
- 3 *Section 24B.* Except in case of emergency, no person
- 4 employed by the commonwealth as a chief power plant
- 5 engineer in a state institution shall be required to work more
- 6 than forty hours in any work week.
