By Mr. Burke of Natick, a petition of Walter T. Burke (by vote of the town) that the town of Natick be authorized to reinstate Joseph Saviano as a member of its public works department for the sole purpose of retirement. Public Service.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF NATICK TO PLACE JOSEPH SAVIANO ON DISABILITY RETIREMENT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding the provisions of any law, the town of
2 Natick may reinstate Joseph Saviano as a member of the
3 public works department of said town for the sole purpose of
4 retirement. Upon said reinstatement, the town of Natick may
5 retire said Joseph Saviano for disability caused and injuries
6 sustained in the actual performance of his duties as a member
7 of said public works department. Said retirement shall be
8 under the provisions of section seven of chapter thirty-two of
9 the General Laws in effect in said town on the date of his
10 termination of employment with said town.

Article 6 of the Warrant for the Special Town Meeting, with the vote thereon, as passed at the First and Final Session held April 9, 1968, at which there was a Quorum present.

Article 6
(Board of Public Works)

To see if the Town will vote to instruct its Representative to the General Court to file a bill seeking authorization for the Retirement Board of the Town of Natick, with the approval of the Board of Selectmen, to retire on account of accidental disability, under the contributory retirement system of said Town, Joseph Saviano, an employee of its Public Works Department, who was injured on March 3, 1963, while in the performance of his duties, notwithstanding that written notice of such injury was not given to the said Retirement Board in accordance with the provisions of General Laws Chapter 32, Section 7 (1) and (3), or otherwise act thereon.

Voted, that the Town instruct its representative to the General Court to file a bill seeking authorization for the Retirement Board of the Town of Natick, with the approval of the Board of Selectmen, to retire on account of accidental disability, under the contributory retirement system of said Town, Joseph Saviano, an employee of its Public Works Department, who was injured on March 3, 1963, while in the performance of his duties, notwithstanding that written notice of such injury was not given to the said Retirement Board in accordance with the provisions of General Laws Chapter 32, Sections 7 (1) and (3).
