AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING THE FUNDING OF SCHOOL BUILDING PROJECTS UNDER THE SCHOOL BUILDINGS ASSISTANCE ACT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 10 of chapter 645 of the acts of 1948, as most recently
2 amended by chapter 746 of the acts of 1987, is hereby further
3 amended by inserting at the end of the first sentence, the following
4 clause: — and (6) priority shall be given to school projects that
5 have been approved and placed on a priority list in the order in
6 which they are approved and any project so approved will advance
7 for funding over any new project approved in any one calendar
8 year and in no event shall an approved project be delayed for
9 funding for more than three years before reaching the highest
10 priority level for funding and said highest priority level project
11 shall be funded before any other project approved subsequent
12 thereto.
