By Mr. Bly of Saugus, petition of Belden G. Bly, Jr., that persons or corporations engaged in the business of installing, repairing or maintaining burglar alarm systems be required to obtain a license from the Commissioner of Public Safety. Government Regulations.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE REPAIR AND MAINTENANCE OF BURGLAR ALARM SYSTEMS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 23 of Chapter 147 of the General Laws, is hereby
2 amended by adding at the end of the first paragraph, the
3 following new paragraph:—No person, partnership, or corpora-
4 tion may engage in the business of installing, repairing, or
5 offering maintenance for burglar alarm systems, for residential
6 dwellings or commercial buildings; or conduct electronic
7 surveillance for another, without first obtaining a license from
8 the Commissioner of Public Safety, and upon posting of a
9 surety bond annually, in the sum of five thousand dollars,
10 executed by the applicant as principal and by a surety company
11 doing business in Massachusetts.
