

# HOUSE . . . . . No. 4645

By Mr. Scaccia of Boston, petition of Angelo M. Scaccia that certain injured employees be granted additional awards under the provision of the workmen's compensation law. Commerce and Labor.

## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Eight.

AN ACT PROVIDING THAT CERTAIN INJURED EMPLOYEES MAY HAVE THEIR AWARDS INCREASED UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF THE WORKMEN'S COMPENSATION LAW.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter 152 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting  
2 after section 51A the following section: —

3 *Section 51B.* An injured employee who attempts to return to  
4 work after receiving compensation under this chapter and finds  
5 that his employer has been adjudged a bankrupt, shall be entitled  
6 to an additional award equal to the amount of vacation pay to  
7 which he was entitled at the time of his injury, but which remained  
8 unpaid.
