AN ACT TO EXEMPT MUNICIPALITIES FROM EXTRA COSTS INCURRED DUE TO PASSAGE OF THE MEDICAL SECURITY ACT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 8 of Chapter 118F of the General Laws, as appearing
2 in the 1990 Official Edition, is hereby amended by adding the
3 following: — Any city or town incurring any expense due to the
4 implementation of the medical security act, Chapter twenty-three
5 of the acts of nineteen hundred and eighty-eight, shall be
6 reimbursed for the full cost thereof by the Commonwealth.
